# ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The (CAAHEP accredited) CRMC Advanced Cardiac Sonography Program was developed in response to the Cardiology and Echocardiography profession request and need to create a career track for sonographers who practice at an advanced level in the echocardiography laboratory. The objective of this educational program is to prepare graduates who are committed to improving lab quality and efficiency through preparing preliminary echo assessments; performing advanced echocardiograms; mentoring fellows, students, residents, and staff; developing and implementing educational plans; facilitating continuous quality improvement; and coordinating cardiac ultrasound research.

#### PROGRAM DESIGN

The hybrid program design will be utilized. The didactic component will be delivered online with minimal SKYPE instruction. The clinical internship (3 separate weeks) will be completed onsite at Community Regional Medical Center in Fresno.
